I have enclosed some additional informations about how to reach Bernried. (Of course you will be refunded for your travel expenses.)



Additional Information:

HOW TO GET FROM MUNICH-AIRPORT TO BERNRIED

From the Airport ("München-Riem") to the Main Railroad Station ("München-Hauptbahnhof"), there is a bus every 30 Minutes at a cost of DM 5.-, the trip will take about 20 minutes.

At the Railroad Station ("Hauptbahnhof"), go underground to the "S-Bahn", and take line no. S6 to Tutzing. (Every 20 or 40 minutes, cost DM 6.90, this part of the trip will take about 40 minutes.

Tutzing is a lovely small town on Lake Starnberg, but still some kilometers away from Bernried. We'll set up a special taxi service (at no cost) from Tutzing railway station to Kloster Bernried. Please take only those taxis with our Summer School Poster!

Therefore, in order to arrive in time on Sunday, June 21, you should leave Munich at about 16.00 to 19.30 hours.
